# **NEW DAILY READING INITIATIVE**

Next term, Wiripaang is excited to announce that we will be launching a new literacy initiative targeting fluency K-6 to strengthen and improve literacy skills.

The program will be targeting fluency to achieve excellence in reading.







According to the Department of Education:

"Reading fluency is the ability to read accurately, smoothly and with expression. Fluent readers recognise words automatically, without struggling over decoding (working out issues). Fluency is important because it allows students time to focus on what the text is saying which in turn improves comprehension "

This program will involve identified students for daily instruction. It will be implemented before school in ten minute intervals. The focus of the program will be to assist with word recognition, improve comprehension and empower confidence in the students. This will be supported by Mrs Quigley, Mrs Smart and our dedicated team of support learning officers. Parents/ carers of targeted students will be contacted by letter or telephone.


