From 29th April to 8th May (Week 1 & 2)

- Students will continue to learn from home.
- Schools will be open and operational for students that need to attend but where practical, parents are encouraged to keep their children at home.
- Students on site will be supervised whilst completing the one mode of 'learning from home' that has been developed for all students.

From Monday 11th May (Week 3)

- Students will attend school one day per week (you will be contacted this week with your child's allocated day)
- Parents and carers are encouraged to send their child to school on their allocated day.
- Schools will still be open and operational for students that need to attend but where practical, parents are encouraged to keep their children at home.

This term we will be continuing to implement strong social distancing measures to support the Health & Safety of our staff and students.

- Please note NO parents or carers will be allowed on our school site.
- We ask that parents and carers have a conversation with their children as to which gate you will be dropping off and picking up, as we ask that until further notice adults do not enter school grounds at pick up and drop off times; preferably adults staying in their cars for your child/children to come to you. We will have staff supervision at both gates.
